# OWL (ACTION REQUIRED)...

### **OWL IS BEING REPLACED BY HERTS CONNECTED ON 1 APRIL 2024**

This is a reminder that the community messaging system for Hertfordshire Constabulary and Neighbourhood Watch will be changing from OWL to Herts Connected with effect from **1 April 2024**. From this date, OWL will be obsolete, so it is important to register your details with the new scheme before this cut-off. Your details will NOT automatically be transferred due to GDPR. To register as an existing OWL subscriber or new user, please go to <a href="https://hertsconnected.co.uk">https://hertsconnected.co.uk</a>. Do not worry about signing up for a specific Neighbourhood Watch area as these are not yet all listed. More information will be sent after the switchover on 1 April 24.
